It had been a while since I had seen her at mass and wanted to ask her for her pizza sauce recipe, which she reminded me was not her recipe, but belonged to her sister. She assured me that Marie has all of the recipes. The last time I saw Mrs. Canto was December 2019 at my mother's funeral. She was what I called a young 90 year old. We cannot believe she has passed.
