He enjoyed going fishing and being around his friends & family. Bud was a fan of the Philadelphia Eagles and Phillies. Bud had a soft spot for animals and loved his many pets. He was also a lifelong member of the Beach Buggy Association. He was also the owner of his barber shop, Hairs to You for 50 years. Bud had a larger than life personality and a love for making people smile around him. He acted as Santa

Claus for nearly 30 years for family & friends holiday parties.

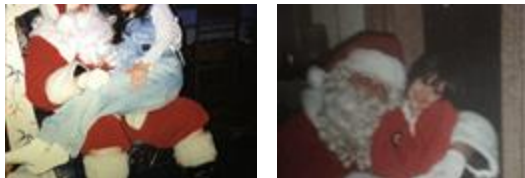
