Anthony A. Mazzagatti passed away peacefully on May 18, 2014 at his daughter's residence in Cinnaminson, NJ. Born in Philadelphia, Tony would have been 95 years old on Tuesday, May 20th. Tony was a resident of Melbourne, FL and formerly of Edgewater Park, NJ. In Melbourne, Tony was a resident of Indian River Colony Club from 1990 to 2013. Tony was the former owner of Beverly Home Supply from 1946 to 1957. He then went into the insurance business where he was Vice-president of Phoenix Mutual Life Insurance Company. Tony proudly served his country in the Army Corps of Engineers during WWII building air fields throughout the South Pacific and remained in the Army Reserves, reaching the rank of Lt. Colonel. Beloved husband of 68 years to Emilia V. (nee Varani) and loving father of Ginny (Garth) Seidel. Grandfather of Nina Pilog and Alex (Jaime) Seidel. Great grandfather of Paisley and Austin Seidel and Connor and Asher Pilog. Brother of A. Ronald Mazzagatti.
