She was honored to be chosen to participate in the “People to People” program where she traveled to Russia and South Africa to meet with numerous Early Childhood Educators to share and learn about different cultures and educational techniques. Her life can be defined by her love for all the children of the world. She impacted all who surrounded her and she will forever be loved.
