This extended all the way down to his final days.

his chef hat. The best Salmon Chef in America. When he prepared his delicacies, Salmon, Christmas Turkey, and many other dishes everyone clamored to share in the feast. He loved food but was not fussy about it at all. He could eat crackers and sardines, or crackers and tuna, or oatmeal with a big heap of raisins and be just as happy and contented as if he had a personal chef cater with a five-course meal. He cooked when he either just wanted to help out or if he thought his skills were in high demand.

It seemed as if faith was on his side when he met the love of his life in New York many years later. This lovely girl, Joy Greene was a hometown girl who he always loved. He pursued her and they fell in love and became a couple. Alexis Wehner and Joy Greene-Wehner loved and cared for each other for over 36 wonderful years until his death. The relationship was full, and the Lord blessed them with the children whom they loved and nurtured.

He fell in love all over again with the Jesus of his childhood. He had a personal relationship with Him and lived daily to serve the Him.
