Frances A. Ade (nee Skalski) passed away peacefully on Saturday, May 20, 2023 at the Masonic Home in Burlington. Born in Flushing, NY to Frank and Sophie Skalski, Frances was 93 years old. She was a resident of Delran since 1969 and formerly lived in Willingboro.

In 1969 Fran relocated to Delran, NJ and remained there until her death.

Fran's life was all about her devotion to her family, friends, church and community. She created a lovely home and was happiest when she was feeding others. She volunteered in church and school organizations and also

was involved with the local Republican committee. Fran was a voracious reader going through at least a book a week. When life slowed her down, she continued to create needlepoint Christmas stockings for family and friends babies and knit wool caps for newborns.
