Gabriel Michael "Mike" Stankiewicz, a resident of Moorestown, previously a resident of Cinnaminson for 56 years, passed away on August 6, 2012 peacefully at Samaritan Hospice at the age of 92.

Mike served in the U.S. Army during WWII as a combat medic, earning the Bronze Star for heroic action in the line of fire. He was a long time member of Palmyra's EMS Squad and worked for Schaevitz Engineering in Pennsauken. Mike also donated blood as frequently as they would allow and was recognized by the American Red Cross for donating over 15 gallons.

Mike is survived by his beloved wife Margaret (nee Hund) of 64 years, loving daughter Michelle and her husband Ira Schonfeld of Cinnaminson, and his dear brother Bernard Stankiewicz. He was a close friend to his deceased brother Vincent's children Victoria, Vincent Junior, William, Anthony and Joseph.
