John T. McInerney, Jr. passed away peacefully on Thursday, August 26, 2021 at his residence surrounded by his family, following five challenging years living with Early Onset Alzheimer's. Born in Philadelphia to John T. And Patricia McInerney, Sr., John was 63 years old. He was a resident of Cinnaminson since 1991 and formerly lived in the Oxford Circle section of Philadelphia.
