John loved his wife Bridie Pedin, whom he met at a ballroom dance. The two of them spent the majority of their lives in Old Tappan, NJ. This is where they raised their children John Pedin, Mark Pedin, Noreen Palmay, and Deirdre Christiano. During the last 15 years of John's life, he and his wife Bridie resided in Waretown, NJ.

John enjoyed the simple pleasures in life, like sitting in the sunshine, sipping on a glass of Merlot, and telling fascinating stories about his career. He loved fixing things around the house while listening to classical music. Although he was simple at heart, he had an expensive palate. John was notorious for leaving brutally honest feedback about other people's substandard cooking. (Perhaps he will become a food critic in Heaven!) All in all, he was a lighthearted man with a great sense of humor.

John is survived by his wife Bridie, his three children Noreen, Mark, and John, and his six grandchildren.
