Joseph W. Bonner, of Delran, died Wednesday, April 22, 2015, at his residence with his family and his two best friends by his side.

A graduate of Palmyra High School, he also attended Temple University and the University of Connecticut. A Vietnam veteran, he served in the U.S. Air Force, and was a member of the American Legion Post 146. 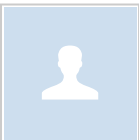
