Karl Heinz Wieladek, of Hi-Nella, NJ since 2018, previously of North Arlington, NJ, passed away unexpectedly on January 13, 2022. Born in Celle, Germany he immigrated to America in 1952 and resided here the rest of his life. He was 73 years old.

Karl was the beloved husband of the late Michelle (Sanzone) Wieladek for 40 years, until her passing in 2017. 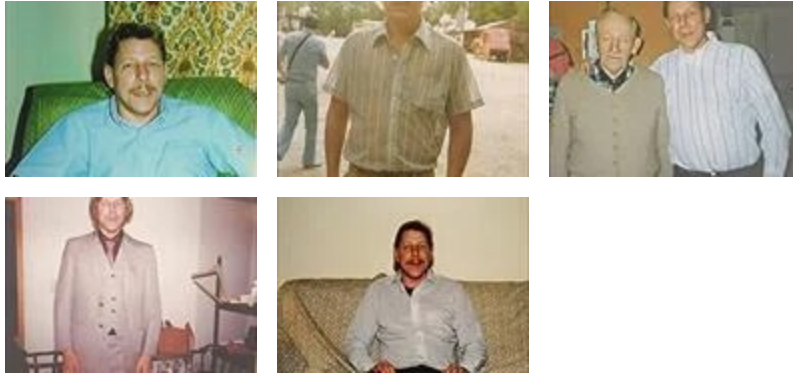
