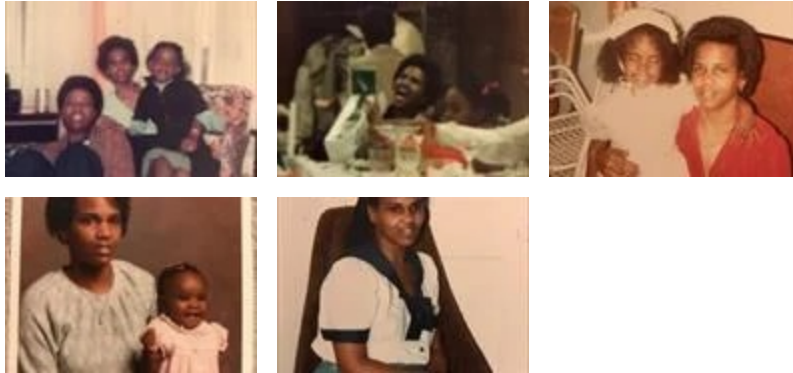

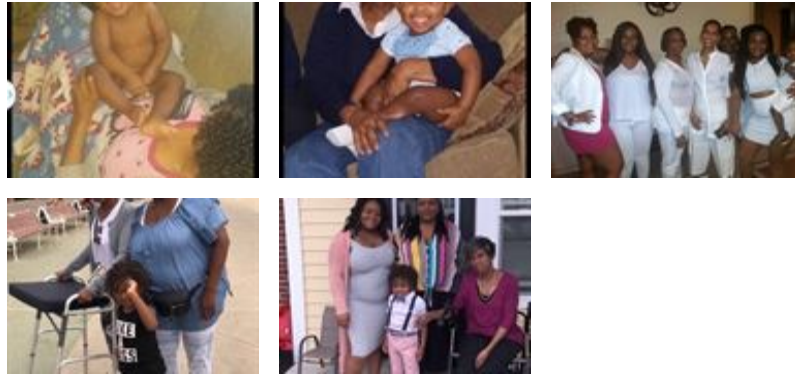
she died My world fell apart.
