Born on February 2, 1978, Matthew "Matt" William Adelman passed away on July 9, 2024. He was a longtime resident of Palmyra, New Jersey where he served as a volunteer firefighter rising in the ranks to officer with the Palmyra Independence Fire Company Station 801 for several years.

Matt devoted much of his life as a servant to others. He saved many lives during his tenure in their rescue department. Matt was a 1996 graduate of Cinnaminson High School. He was a highly skilled talented carpenter by trade, building several homes in the Moorestown area.

Matt is survived by his loving mother, Sheryl Adelman (nee Fynan) who currently resides in Jacksonville, Florida; by his brother Mark Adelman, his sister-in-law Krystal Adelman (nee Quinn), his nephews Luke, Jack and Leo, and his niece Ella - all residing in Jacksonville, Florida.
