This fund has been established to help Mike's wife Barbara with the astronomical medical/hospital bills and final arrangements. As we all know, COVID wreaked havoc in all aspects of the economy but the entertainment business suffered tremendously with venues, restaurants and bars having to

close and shows and concerts cancelled. Mike's paper, and sole source of income, Out On The Town was completely shutdown since early 2020. The bills will be staggering even with the Medicare coverage he had.

It's now our turn to honor Mike's memory by doing all we can to give support to the most important people in his life, his wife and family."

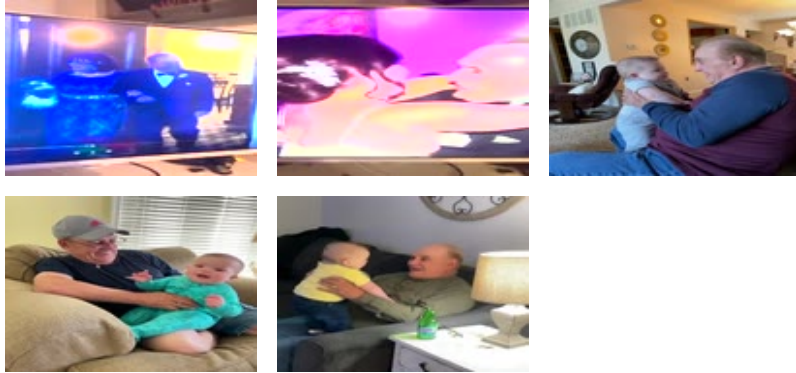
