No suits for Paul, his uniqueness made him stand out to the people he worked with.

In the outdoors, Paul shined the most. Rock climbing and repelling, sailing, skiing, hiking, and driving our Jeep Wrangler through Wharton Forest back roads are just a few of his favorite activities. He would climb to the highest point of buildings and bridges he was working on, and stand on the edge with no fear.
