May 10, 1949 - July 28, 2017

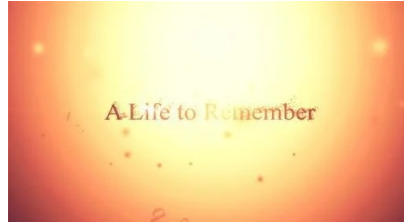

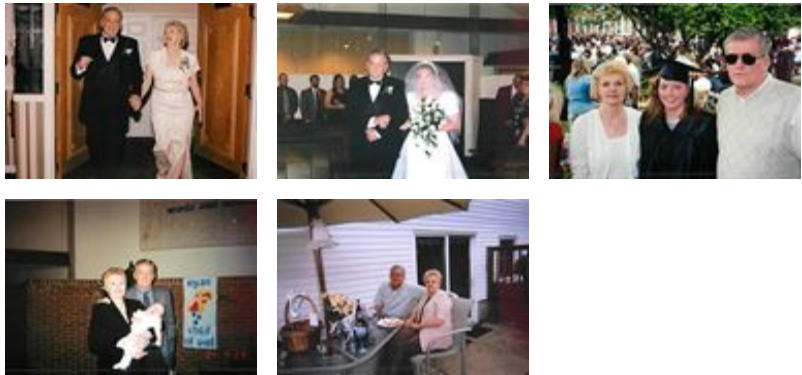
