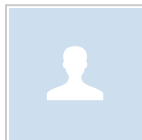
“ How do you say goodbye to a good friend, a fellow coach, the father of two young children - who himself was still young? How do you say goodbye to someone who's not still here to say goodbye to? How do you say goodbye to someone who should still be here, in your everyday life? How do you say goodbye to the husband of someone so close to you? With so many unanswered questions still, how do you say goodbye? I've had the chance to know Tony, actually "Sal" as he was known to me for many years. I've had the opportunity to coach several baseball teams with Sal. Together, we coached our sons and together we watched them grow up. It wasn't until recently that our sons parted; both on to other sports and activities. Sal and I never stopped being friends, but both continued on to follow our sons different paths. For us, that meant not really seeing one another on a weekly basis as we had for so long. Staying in touch, as with so many people became unroutine, not for any reason - but just because we no longer were at the same place at the same time. But every time we did cross paths, it was like I had seen him yesterday and we just picked up where we left off. And so life went on..... I hadn't had a chance to talk to Sal for a while until an unusual event brought us together this summer. It wasn't an "in-person" thing but we did talk on the phone for a few minutes, both agreeing that we would catch-up soon to talk about how we both got to where we were that day. I had no idea that would be the last time that I would get to talk to Sal. My goodbye that day was the usual, the way that any of us might end a cell phone call these days, "Alright brotha, I'll catch up with you soon!" It really make one think, you see until very recently, I was one of those people, always thinking about sometime in the future. I've always been that way, but something my wife said to me really got through my thick head that day. "You have to stop thinking about what the future holds and start living in today." When we're born, there are no guarantees, there is no promise of tomorrow. All we know is that we have right now and you need to take advantage of right now. Her message that day became clear for some reason, that day I listened. While I have to say that it's not easy at all to change the way you think, act and feel overnight, her message is now a constant in my head. I often stop myself and think about what she said before I act now. Sal was only 46 years old, with so much life left to live! With so much more to do and see and experience. But..... His life ended and now we're left with how to say goodbye? I'm sure that there's many people in his life, Just like me that aren't ready to say goodbye yet to him. But that's not up to me or you, we don't get to make the rules, we don't get to change his history. I still have so many things I wanted to talk to him about, arguments about baseball to have with him, good times to share with him. But I'm being selfish, Sal was just a friend of mine - and while there were things for him and I left to do, there was so much left for him to do as a dad. Things to share with his sons' that they won't get to experience together. I'm so sad for his family, there's no words, there's no anything that I can say or do for them that could ever come close to their dad. He'll be greatly missed by many of us, but no one will miss him more than those the closest to him. I pray for Joanna, Cristian and Sean - may you find strength in each other and as the days pass, you become closer and continue to share good times together. My family will always be here for you and we will do anything that we can to help you now and

always. Live everyday to the fullest and at the end of each day, make time for each other, for those closest to you.

Goodbye Sal, may god have a place for you by his side and may your family find resolve in this time of sorrow.
