Steve was a published author, having written the book "Counted Out" "The Battle That Never Ends" which chronicled his battle with non-testicular cancer. His battle began at the age of 26 when he received the devastating diagnosis. He would

live 40+ years cancer free. After his treatment he went on to volunteer with the Camden County chapter of the American Cancer Society. In 1984 he received a plaque recognizing his efforts in organizing the 1984 Swim Marathon. He was also awarded a plaque from the Camden County Unit of the American Cancer Society for the 1984-85 year for being recognized as "Volunteer of the Year." Steve and his wife loved to spend a week in Ocean City each summer enjoying all that the shore town had to offer. They also spent a few days each February in Cape May. Ever since they honeymooned there they had fallen in love with Cape May.
