Walter F. Deitz passed away peacefully on January 25, 2014 in Camden, NJ. Born in Camden, Walt was 84 years old. He was a resident of Palmyra for over 75 years. He was very active in community affairs, serving as Palmyra Police dispatcher, coaching little league teams and was a past Palmyra Zoning Board president. Walt loved playing football in high school and semi-pro for Palmyra. He played a prominent part in the record setting 12-1 team in 1948. Walter proudly served his country in the US Navy during the Korean War, serving on the USS Missouri. He was a long time member of the Central Baptist Church and served in many different capacities.
