William Robert Jackamonis, Jr., of Delran, NJ, passed away peacefully with his loving family by his side on January 20, 2026. Born in Mount Holly, NJ, to the late William Robert Jackamonis, Sr. and Mary Jackamonis (nee Manes), he was 72 years old.

Bill was raised in Burlington City, NJ, and later lived in Riverside before settling in Delran, where he and his wife raised their family. He was the beloved husband of nearly 50 years to Jacqueline Marie Jackamonis (nee Catanzariti). Married in 1976, their love story began when they met at a baseball game, a fitting start to a life centered around family and sports.

A devoted and loving father, Bill was the proud dad of Bill Jackamonis III (Amanda) and Jill Nocito (Anthony). He proudly ran the parish carnival, served as President of the Usher Society, and was a familiar and welcoming voice calling Bingo. Known for his generous spirit, Bill loved to work, loved to help people, and was always a welcome source of advice. He also enjoyed family trips to Ocean City and was famous among family and friends for his homemade limoncello.
